POSITION STRUCTURE

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Monitor and maintain health of all animals at the EPRC
- Develop and implement preventative health management to reduce animal morbidity and mortality and risks of zoonosis
- Train EPRC animal care staff for effective monitoring of animal health and basic preventative health procedures
- Ensure appropriate care and quarantine for rescued animals
- Perform appropriate health checks for release animals
- Perform post mortems and co ordinate post mortem sample analysis for accurate diagnosis
- Communicate and collaborate with wildlife veterinarians in Vietnam and abroad to improve veterinary care of Vietnamese primates
- Maintain detailed reports on individual animal health
- Provide regular and detailed reports on animal health and activities to the EPRC Director and Veterinary advisor
- Support capacity building of EPRC veterinary team
- Facilitate research projects undertaken by undergraduate and post graduate candidates from Vietnam and overseas
- Develop and implement systems for efficient sample analysis for rapid diagnosis of diseased primates
- Develop and implement staff health program to eliminate risks of zoonotic disease transfer
